

Bacon Appetizer Crescents



- 1 pkg. (8 oz.) Cream Cheese, softened
- 2 slices Bacon, crisply cooked, crumbled
- 1/3 cup Grated Parmesan Cheese
- 1/4 cup finely chopped green or red onion
- 2 Tbsp. chopped fresh parsley (optional)
- 1 Tbsp. milk
- 2 cans (8 oz. each) refrigerated crescent dinner rolls

(If you're also making the Torta from the recipe above, make extra torta middle. It makes a great filling too! Just add bacon!)

PREHEAT oven to 375°F. Mix cream cheese, bacon, Parmesan cheese, onions, parsley and milk until well blended; set aside.

Separate the triangles and fill with heaping tablespoon of above mixture and roll as usual. Place on ungreased baking sheet.

BAKE 12 to 15 min. or until golden brown. Serve warm.

Can be made ahead, chilled and reheated.
